

4-H Summer Ventures are programs sponsored by Perquimans County 4-H. The programs will run throughout the summer. All activities are open to all boys and girls. For more details, contact the Perquimans County Extension Center at 252-426-7697. Classes will be filled on a first come first serve basis. **Refunds will only be given if a class is cancelled.** We must have a minimum of 5 participants to sign up in order to have the program. The program will time stamp all entries and we will go by this official data when creating our lists of participants. If you do not have access to the internet, please visit the Perquimans County Library. **After you have registered online, all forms and payments are due to the Perquimans County Extension Center within 7 business days.** Failure to do so will result in your child's name being moved to the bottom of the list. If you would like to place your child on the waiting list for any of the full workshops, please call the Perquimans County Extension Center. **We have a new enrollment system this year. You will need to setup a new profile once you are on the 4-H Online database. Once your profile has been setup you will follow the steps prompted on each page. "Sew" in to Summer


When: June 11th - June 12th

Master Chef




